



Baby Photoshoot Guidelines

From 8 days to pre-crawling, we enjoy thinking of unique ways to freeze these precious moments for you. Through different poses, lighting, and props, we capture your baby in a unique way for a unique portrait. Also included are shots with mom/dad and siblings. We provide props, but also welcome props you may want to bring. All shoots are either in studio or on location.

Below, you will find tips that may make your photography experience better. Thank you for giving us this opportunity to capture your child!

What to Expect:

- Most important thing is to bring a tired and hungry baby
**Note that baby will be eating throughout the photoshoot*
- Newborn photo shoots are best done in the first 9 days of life, after that they get stronger and fussier
- If you would like to showcase sentimental things in the photos, be sure to bring those to the photo shoot
- If you have a specific theme in mind, be sure to mention that beforehand. If not, we have traditional themes and backgrounds.
- We supply baby swaddles and props (baskets, etc.), if you have something specific in mind then you may bring it
- If there are any props that we do not have, we can purchase them at an extra cost (Ex. Cake, balloons, etc)
- If shooting in studio, be aware that we will have a space heater going to make a warm space for the baby
- Depending on how cooperative the baby is, the photoshoot can take anywhere from 1-2 hours
 - Anticipate a photo with mom and dad, and siblings
